As this is our Xmas dive we will add to the charter with a few extra goodies and amusing (hopefully) awards. The food fare on PEACE is always outstanding and plentiful. The first day wil provide heavy duty diving for those so inclined with up to 6 to 8 dives viable. The second day will be more leisurely with 3 or 4 dives anticipated.

LET'S TRY SAN CLEMENTE'S BACKSIDE

9 JANUARY (Saturday)

For our first dive of 1993 we move back to the "new" (see article below) CHARISMA and take the big boat out from 22nd Street to the backside of SAN CLEMENTE Island. We plan to head on down to the backside at least halfway then select our spots working back towards the inside areas off the northwest tip of the island.

Over the past couple of lobster seasons we have observed many LOBSTER in this particular area of the island. The infamous 3-3/16" syndrome should have produced a bunch that are now legal!! The diving is typically extremely pleasant with a wide variation of underwater topography and depths from 0 to 80 feet. Some of the reefs support purple hydrocoral and other forms of sea life provide excellent opportunities for PHOTOGRAPHY. Visibility is usually good to excellent due to the volocanic nature of the ocean bed and is typically higher in the winter months. Kelp beds and the reef structures provide a home for a variety of FISH and SCALLOPS.

This dive is suitable for all skill levels (ocean conditions permitting); last year the diving at SAN CLEMENTE was outstanding. Call for early sign-up at (310) 370-1657. Kathi (McNally) will take your call. DON'T MISS THIS GREAT DIVE ON A BIG BOAT!!


CHARISMA AND ENCORE FIRE REPORT

As many of you probably know both the CHRISMA and the ENCORE were badly damaged by an arsonist about 1:00 AM the night of Monday/Tuesday 9/10 November 1992. Gasoline was poured over both boats and apparently ENCORE was flamed first by someone throwing a flare onto the upper deck. While people on the docks ran towards the ENCORE, the flames jumped across onto the CHARISMA. The 22nd Street people apparently were able to control the flames on ENCORE but CHARISMA became fully engulfed taking the LA Fire Department about 20 minutes to extinguish.

I visited 22nd Street on Saturday the 14th and toured CHARISMA with John H's permission. Damage to the galley seating area was extensive and the Hess's and crew were tearing out the center island and all of the booths and tables. The actual galley was not seriously damaged. All the windows were gone and big holes were apparent in some of the fiberglass between the galley area, the sundeck and the port side of the aft bunk area. The bunk area was also damaged by water from the fire fighting. Outside – especially on the port side next to the ENCORE the fiberglass was stained and damaged. John's estimate was 3-4 weeks of repairs. We have CHARISMA on 9 January 1993 – so should be a "new" boat by them. Engine room, bridge, etc., were not seriously damaged.

ENCORE was out diving . . . "not looking real good" with repaired fiberglass and undercoat; the sundeck "off limits" and an outdoor carpet covering damaged deck surfaces just behind the galley area entry.


